

- ✓ There are over 43,982 airports in the world. 832 of them are International
- ✓ 5.7 Billion people fly each year
- ✓ In North America, 763 Million people fly in and out of 68 specific airports – over 2 million people every day
- ✓ In Europe, over 700 Million fly in and out of 20 specific airports – 35 Million per airport each year

If 100 people watched the 2 minute video every day at each of the 832 international airports, 83,200 people would be trained every day or 30.3 million people trained every year.
